## COMMENTS & INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Bottle Glass

Clear, Green, Amber and Brown Jars  
And Bottles. Remove caps and lids.  
Empty and rinse clean. Labels are o.k.  
Do not Break. **NO** Window Glass, **NO**  
Light Bulbs, **NO** Pyrex, **NO** Ceramics,  
**NO** Auto Glass, **NO** Cups, Dishes,  
Saucers, or Ovenware.  
**NO Trace of Contents.**

(Note: Clear glass  
will be collected  
separately from  
colored)

### Metal Cans

Tin and aluminum food and beverage cans,  
pie plates, baking sheets, and aluminum foil.  
EMPTY aerosol cans are accepted. Empty  
and rinse or wipe clean. No need to remove  
labels. Cans may be crushed (saves on  
trucking costs). **NO** plastic lids or caps.  
**NO** metal banding or wire.  
**NO TRACE OF FOOD.**

### Plastic Bottles

NO toys  
NO Bags  
NO Lids  
NO Caps  
NO Pails  
NO Styrofoam  
NO Peanuts  
NO Sheeting  
NO Buckets

Most Plastic Bottles are accepted. Examples:  
Detergent, juice, milk, shampoo, water.  
Remove and discard caps and lids. Empty  
and rinse clean. Plastic bottles with any  
remaining contents will not be recycled.  
**WE DO NOT ACCEPT MOTOR OIL  
BOTTLES.** We DO NOT accept any plastic  
pails or tubs such as yogurt, cottage cheese,  
baby wipes, tofu, peanut butter, microwave  
trays or joint compound pails.  
Please dispose of all unacceptable plastic with  
your household garbage.

### Aseptic Packs

We accept Aseptic Juice and Milk cartons.  
Empty and rinse clean. Remove straws  
And flatten. **CONTAINERS WHICH ARE  
NOT RINSED AND FLATTENED WILL  
NOT BE RECYCLED.**

## FOR USE BY PERMIT ONLY

The following items **ARE NOT** accepted:  
automobiles or trailers, hazardous waste,  
including: asbestos, pesticides, herbicides,  
fungicides, lead based paint, gasoline, kerosene,  
solvents, acids, driveway sealer and chemicals.

Please **DO NOT** bring any of the above items to  
the Transfer Station. Violators will be subject  
to the penalties of the Berlin Local Law of 1989.  
Please save your hazardous waste for the next  
Hazardous Waste Collection Day.

The following materials will be collected separately for disposal or recycling:

MATERIALS	COMMENTS & INSTRUCTIONS
<b>HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE</b>	All non-recyclable household waste. Accepted bagged or loose. <b>PLEASE NO HAZARDOUS WASTE.</b>
<b>SCRAP METAL</b>	Old stoves, tools pipes Bicycles, sheet metal, <b>EMPTY</b> paint Cans, etc.
<b>CONSTRUCTION and DEMOLITION WASTE</b>	Plaster, lath, sheet rock, lumber, insulation, rubble, concrete, windows, doors, etc.
<b>BULKY GOODS</b>	Furniture, mattresses, box springs,  Carpeting, etc.
<b>TIRES</b>	Auto, truck, or tractor tires, with or without rims.
<b>USED MOTOR OIL</b>	Please drain filters and collect used oil in plastic jugs.
<b>USED OIL FILTERS</b>	Please keep oil free from Rainwater or other automotive fluids.
<b>ANTI- FREEZE</b>	Collect in plastic jugs
<b>CAR BATTERIES</b> <b>HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES</b>	All types and sizes accepted.
<b>YARD WASTE</b>	<b>Not at this time</b>

The following materials will be collected separately for recycling. (Based on market availability, materials may be added or deleted at a future time.)

MATERIALS	COMMENTS & INSTRUCTIONS
<b>NEWSPAPERS</b>	Dry, uncontaminated newspaper with inserts. Pack in paper bags or bundle with twine. <b>NO</b> plastic
<b>MAGAZINES</b>	Dry, glossy magazines and catalogs. bundle with twine or pack in bags or boxes. Newspaper inserts, paperbacks, Computer paper, telephone books <b>NO HARDCOVER BOOKS</b>
<b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b>	Dry, uncontaminated corrugated cardboard. Remove any styrofoam packing or peanuts. Flatten boxes. bundle with twine or pack in cardboard box. <b>NO</b> wax coated cardboard.
<b>BOX-BOARD MIX</b>	Cereal and shoe box type Cardboard. Remove any poly liners and flatten. Pack in paper bags or boxes. Kraft bags, bond paper, note paper, computer paper, and manila folders are also accepted with this material.  No plastic window envelopes or boxes. <b>NO</b> trace of food, <b>NO</b> glossy magazines or catalogs, <b>NO</b> disposable cups or plates.
<b>PHONE BOOKS</b>	Bring in your phone books for collection. Remove and discard any poly covers.
