Prior to land use, zoning changes or development permitting the city will review the hazard mitigation plan and other hazard analysis to ensure consistent and compatible land use. . • Comprehensive Land Use Plan- A land use plan is intended to identify land use issues and to make recommendations on how to address these issues. When applicable the city will incorporate Hazard Mitigation Actions in the development and extent of the regulations.
